

## EPAS Desktop Installation Note

### Installing EPAS Desktop

Before you can run EPAS Desktop you must install it on the hard disk of your computer.

Follow these steps to install the software:

- Switch on your computer and log on in the normal way.
- Insert the EPAS Desktop CD into the CD drive. The EPAS Desktop Setup Wizard dialog will appear automatically.
- Click **Next**.
- Choose the installation folder for the software and click **Next**.
- Click **Next** again to complete the installation.
- Click **Close** once the installation is complete.
- The installation process places shortcuts to EPAS Desktop on the computer's desktop and Start menu.

#### NOTES:

1. If the EPAS Desktop installation process does not start automatically, you can start it manually by using My Computer or Windows Explorer to navigate to the contents of the CD and then double-clicking the file SETUP.EXE.
2. EPAS Desktop requires the Microsoft .NET framework to be installed on your computer. To do this run **dotnetfx.exe** from the installation CD before installing EPAS Desktop.
3. To install Microsoft Internet Explorer 6, if required, run **ie6setup.exe** from the installation CD.

This will remove the EPAS Desktop software together with its shortcuts and configuration entries.
